Check-Mate FAQs

What is the Child Check Systems installation deadline?

Title 13, states that the Child Check System must be installed on or before the beginning of the 2018/2019 school year, but now you must be compliant March 1st 2019. Minor districts serving less than 4000 students who have filed special paperwork with CHP may be allowed an additional time if approved by the CHP. We do not recommend

Who is required to have the Child Check System installed?

Operators of, school pupil activity buses (SPAB), youth buses, and childcare vehicles are required.

What types of Child Check System units are required for installation?

Units that are compliant with the California Code of Regulations, Section 1294 are acceptable. Some devices are currently not compliant with the regulation. Beware of companies that are cutting into your brake system or are unable to provide you copies of the law and how they install their system to be compliant.

Will buses – prior to the adoption of Section 1294 – with already installed units be grandfathered in with the new regulations?

The California Highway Patrol is not grandfathering schools who have already installed child check systems that do not meet the new regulatory requirements. If your child check system does not meet the current conditions, you are required to install a system that does meet the requirement stated in Section 1294.

What if our school buses are not compliant with the Child Safety Alert System regulations on March 1st, 2019?

Our understanding is that school buses not fully compliant March 1st, 2019 will not have their 292 cards renewed/signed off until they meet the mandated requirements.

What are the costs of the child check unit and installation?
